The Scottish Ministers (the Licensing Authority) in exercise of the power conferred by Paragraph 21 of the Schedule to the Deposits in the Sea (Exemptions) Order 1985 approve the use of:-

Micro-Fiton (the product) as a Bioremediation Agent

within United Kingdom controlled waters adjacent to Scotland.

This approval shall remain in force until **31 May 2014** unless revoked at an earlier date by the Licensing Authority. It shall be subject to the following conditions:

1. the product shall not be used except as stated at the time of the application for approval, or in accordance with any subsequent instructions issued by the Manufacturer or Approval Holder and approved by the Licensing Authority.
2. in respect of use in waters adjacent to Scotland the Manufacturers must include in the 'Instructions to Users' the following condition and warning that the product shall not be used:

In an area of the sea of a depth less than 20 metres or within one mile of such area except in accordance with a specific authorisation from the Scottish Government.
3. only the product label provided by the Approval Holder and accepted by the Licensing Authority shall be used on supplies of the product marketed in the United Kingdom.
4. the Approval Holder shall not change the composition of the Product, or the source of its raw material from that given in the application for approval without the prior notification to and the agreement of the Licensing Authority. If any change in any respect is made without the agreement of the Licensing Authority the Product must be withdrawn from use. In such cases the agreement of the Licensing Authority must be obtained before the Product is put back into use.

5. any changes to the name and address of the Approval Holder must be brought to the attention of the Licensing Authority.
